**Need Route and % of kids picked up at home numbers:** Our online form does not allow for the input of routes and children picked up at home. Please let me know how many routes your program has this semester and what % of kids are picked up at home.

For example, Hay's program is a "staging post" and everyone is dropped off at a location and then walked to school. Hays has "open enrollment" and very few children live within a walkable distance. So Hay's answer would be "0% of kids are walked from home." However, in a City like Stockton the answer may be close to 100% are picked up from home. **Please put that information into your online form.**
